

The next edition of the Ball will take place on Saturday 02 March 2019 and will have the title and theme The Magnificent Ephemeral, in Praise of Dream, Folly and Sin.

The "magic box" of style

Atelier Scatola Magica: fashion, period and dance costumes

Palazzo Zanardi is a surprising Venetian address in fashion, costumes, and corsetry: the unusual **Atelier Scatola Magica** overlooks a 16th Century garden in a charming location that once was home to a cookie factory in the 1920s. Two stylist sisters welcome customers with an entirely tailor-made production: theatrical costumes, mischievous corsets, professional dance costumes, and a smaller but significant collection of women's clothing and accessories. The pieces alternate in an unusual gallery of exclusive items that, for Carnival and events, are tailor-made or available for hire. Walking through the costumes, corsets, and by the many hats is like making an excursion through centuries of fashion trends, reinvented in style but not in a serial manner. This is the incomparable advantage of craftsmanship and originality, even in the smallest or hidden details, that summarizes the quality of the Made in Italy, with touches of theatrical



fantasy.





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

Discovering Mexico and Europe through different artistic visions

'he abstract art of Josef Albers is hosted by the Peggy Guggenheim Collection until 3rd September. It's possible to discover, through a hundred works, among paintings, photographs and photo-collages, the very close relationship that linked the German artist to Mexico. The exhibition Josef Albers in Mexico highlights the relationship between the abstract art of Albers and the strongly geometrical forms of the pre-Columbian monuments that the artist was able to study during his many trips to Mexico. Next to the young paintings and works on paper, there is also a rich selection of photographs and photo-collages, presented for the first time to the public, which allows to further contextualise the still little known photographic production of Albers, thus offering a new reading of his most famous abstract works.

From September 22nd, the museum rooms is giving way to the tribute, sixty years after his death,



to **Osvaldo Licini**, an artist from the Marche region, a leading figure in the Italian art scene of the first half of the 20th century. With over a hundred works, from the figurative origins to its latest abstract productions, the exhibition *Osvaldo Licini: Let Sheer Folly Sweep*

Me Away traces the disruptive artistic career of the artist who lived the international Parisian environment. There he met Modigliani and deepened Cubism, but also spent a good part of his life in Monte Vidon Corrado, a beloved birthplace. After the early Realists of the 1920s, Licini dedicated much of his artistic production to abstractionism, determining the ethical and poetic terms of this movement in Italy between the '30s and '40s.

Until November 25, in the *Project Rooms* of the museum, it will also be held *1948: the Biennial of Peggy Guggenheim*, an exhibition-tribute to the historic Venice Biennale of '48 where Peggy exhibited his

collection of avant-gardes, within the spaces of Greek Pavilion, meticulously reconstructed thanks to a very faithful maquette.



The museum brings to life the deeds of the fieriest Venetian in history




there is a multimedia experience that integrates textual elements, original eighteenth-century finds traceable to Casanova, videos and virtual reality. Thanks to 3D technology (VR) it will be possible to discover the world of Casanova and relive some of the moments that have marked its incredible life. Calli and campielli, courtyards

and historical buildings, the journey through the life of the Latin lover winds through the most secret places of the city, with a Venice that tells the theater of his adventures not only amorous. It is a world that strikes, fascinates and sometimes disorients: a mix of intrigues, spells, perfumes, conspiracies and corrupt customs.

of his legend. Casanova was a restless son of his time and, as he described in the History of my Life, also an extraordinary seducer who loved and was loved by many women. Casanova was a great connoisseur of the feminine soul and made his name the emblem of the seducer and the libertine. He traveled throughout Europe: Switzerland, the Netherlands, Germany, Russia, Poland, Spain; he also lived in London where, however, he incurred amorous disasters. After endless adventures he ended his life as a librarian in the castle of the Count of Waldstein, in Duchov, Czech Republic. Here he died on 4 June 1798.

The *Magister Canova* exhibition, hosted at the Scuola Grande della Misericordia, fuses together show and deepening, emotion and knowledge in a sort of continuous contemporary dialogue.

the Scuola Grande della Misericordia, there is a site-specific installation, a magnificent "tribute" to the great Canova and a work that aims to symbolize the journey in the mind of the Venetian sculptor.

The exhibition then continues on the upper floor, where the heart of the exhibition itinerary is set up:"Il Giacimento", a grandiose place inspired

by the Carrara white marble quarries, built in textile architecture. Inside, in six rooms, the visitor's exciting journey unfolds to discover the life and works of Antonio Canova. To accompany, step by step, the guest, there will be the narrative voice of Adriano Giannini, called to read also some letters of the young Canova, while the original soundtrack is entrusted to the composer and cellist Giovanni Sollima.

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Tintoretto's overwhelming vitality on show after 500 years

Palazzo Ducale homages the "Maestro" and his artistic maturity

n extraordinary event for an extraordinary An extraordinary event for an entrance of Analysis and An celebrate the 500th anniversary of the birth of one of the greatest artists of all time: Jacopo Robusti, better known as "Tintoretto". The artist's nickname, Tintoretto, - which derives from the trade of his father, a dyer of fabrics - is closely tied to the lagoon city. He was born in Venice between 1518 and 1519 and he took his first steps in painting in the city, eventually gaining major recognition as 'official' artist for the Scuola Grande di San Rocco. Many are also the paintings executed for the Doge's Palace, including one of his most important works, the immense Paradise, one of the largest paintings in the world, made in pieces between 1588 and 1592.

This great event will start on 7 September with two concurrent exhibitions, one in the Doge's Palace, which will present the amazing creative vitality of the mature Tintoretto, and the other at the Gallerie dell'Accademia, which will instead display his youthful works that led to the establishment of his reputation, the whole forming an integrated

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itinerary of extraordinary masterpieces from leading public and private collections around the world. Tintoretto 1519 - 1594 comes eighty years after the last Venetian exhibition dedicated to the great artist (1937) and includes some extraordinary masterpieces on loan from America and Europe, making it possible to reread his work in greater detail, thanks also to the latest studies and some fundamental restorations. The Prado of Madrid will be sending Joseph and the wife of Potiphar (circa 1555), Judith and Holofernes (1552-1555) and The Rape of Helen (1578-1579), while the famous and fascinating Susanna and the Elders, a masterpiece of 1555-1556 will be coming from the Kunsthistorisches Museum of Vienna and the

noble Portrait of Giovanni Mocenigo (circa 1580) from the Staatliche Museen of Berlin.

The scuole of San Rocco and San Marco will be participating in the Tintoretto year alongside the museums, with original exhibitions, publications and conferences, along with the Patriarchal Curia and the many churches that still preserve fine works by the great artist

Fashion and design between Venice and Mestre thanks to Fiorucci and motorcycles

The Venetian Galleria d'Arte Moderna in Ca' Pesaro and the nineteenth-century Forte Marghera in Mestre host two important exhibitions in a contemporary and 'light' style linked to the worlds of fashion and design. The first is a colourful tribute to the "Epoca Fiorucci" (23 June 2018 - 13 January 2019), with the designer's icons and his revolutionary approach to style and society. The exhibition investigates the pyrotechnical creativity the famous and much-lamented Milanese of





designer Elio Fiorucci, defined "champion of democratic fashion". The second concerns one of the most appealing symbols of twentieth-century design, the motorcycle. The exhibition explores the extraordinary evolution of the two-wheeled machine through a display of 41 motorcycles and scooters, among which some of the most famous aerodynamic forms of motorcycle design from Italy and beyond.



Architecture Exhibition

Golden Lion to Switzerland and special mention to Great Britain

he 16th International Architecture Exhibition takes place from May 26th to November 25th 2018 in the Giardini, the Arsenale, and around other venues in Venice. Yvonne Farrell and Shelley McNamara titled the 16th International Architecture Exhibition Freespace, focuses on architecture's ability to provide free and additional spatial gifts to those who use it and on its ability to address the unspoken

wishes of strangers. Freespace architecture's celebrates capacity to find additional and unexpected generosity in each project, even within the most private, defensive, exclusive or commercially restricted conditions.

Freespace provides the opportunity to emphasise nature's free gifts of light sunlight and moonlight, air, gravity, materials - natural and man-made resources.

Freesbace encourages reviewing ways of thinking, new ways of seeing the world, of inventing solutions where architecture provides for the well being and dignity of each citizen of this fragile planet.

The jury's prizes were won Switzerland (Golden by Lion) and Great Britain (Special Mention). But also by Eduardo Souto de Moura (Portugal, Golden Lion); Jan



de Vylder, Inge Vinck, Jo Taillieu (Belgium, Silver Lion); Andra Matin (Indonesia, Special Mention) and Rahul Mehrotra (India, Special Mention).

Freespace: the 16. International Philosophy, art and architecture in the Machines à penser

Prada Foundation offers a journey that explores exile and thought

he project explores the correlation between conditions of exile, escape and withdrawal and the physical or mental places that favor reflection, thought intellectual production. Machines à penser focuses on three fundamental figures of twentieth century philosophy: Theodor W. Adorno (1903-1969), Martin Heidegger (1889 - 1976) and Ludwig Wittgenstein (1889-1951). The



exhibition is developed on the ground floor and on the first floor of the eighteenthcentury building in an immersive journey that deepens the figures of the three



thinkers and the relationship between philosophy, art and architecture.

Adorno is the protagonist of the first part of the exhibition, in which his American exile is evoked through the interiors of Villa Aurora in Los Angeles.

On the first floor of Ca' Corner della Regina, Heidegger's house in the Black Forest is evoked

through a reconstruction (reduced to 88%) which houses a series of photographs, ceramic objects and photographic prints of two works of art originally present in the

house. Inside the reconstruction small house of the of Wittgenstein in Skjolden in Norway is exhibited the only sculpture made by the Austrian-British philosopher, Head of a girl (1925-1928), together with some of his personal objects.

Hidden jewels of Venice

A circuit that allows to discover the city, starting from Scala Contarini del Bovolo and Oratorio dei Crociferi

The Scala, commissioned by Pietro Contarini at the end of 1400s, is a perfect combination of multiple architectural styles: Renaissance, Gothic, and Venetian-Byzantine. It is a real Venetian jem, one of its kind. The last floor offers a unique view over the city: from here, you can admire views of Saint Mark's Church, Saint Mark's Tower, and the Teatro La Fenice opera house.

Scala Contarini del Bovolo is a really fascinating attraction both in terms of art and architecture. From 23 October, the palace will increase its appeal presenting an exhibition of great cultural impact. I volti della Pietas Veneziana - The faces of Venetian Pietas is curated by Fondazione Venezia Servizi and the Observatory For The Arts, in cooperation with I.R.E.Venezia.

The exhibition is focused on a remarkable number of paintings of the 15th, 16th, and 17th centuries. Most of them come from private collections of Venetian institutions and are of high prestige.

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Crime versus justice, tortures and executions in Venice

Atrocities and brutalities of the past on show at palazzo Zaguri

he suggestive venetian palace hosts the exhibition Venice Secrets, Crime and Justice.

A ground-breaking show, illustrating the darker aspects of Venetian history through the theme of justice, with unique items and peculiar reconstructions, debunking myths and false myths about one of the most longlived, and avant-garde under various aspects,

historical realities within the European panorama. The exhibition circuit is structured in four sections: inquests and torture, prisons and prisoners, capital executions, the Inquisition between myths and legends.

The thirty-six showcasing rooms will offer to the visitors the opportunity of viewing hundreds of instruments for torture and death, dozens of paintings, period garments and ancient books, all displayed to the world for the very first time. The show is a deep research project emerging from libraries, museums and private collections, from Italy and abroad.

Experts have reconstructed inquisition cells, and an anatomical theatre with plastinated corpses recalling how, in the past, executed persons were used for scientific purposes.

International scholars and famous writers have worked in order to narrate and bring back to life great tragedies, like the ones regarding the Doge Marin Falier or the Count of Carmagnola, or libertines like Lorenzo Da Ponte and Giacomo Casanova, who both used to frequent during their lives Ca' Zaguri. The exhibition shows not only the terrifying spectacles of death sentences and the hellish punishments inflicted, but also the

many folk spin-offs about the poor Fornareto or the monster Biagio Luganegher.

In addition to such stories, are also revealed the secrets of the magistrate benches which made up the structure of the State. Ample space is dedicated to the Holy Office through several examples: from the clash between the Republic of Venice and the Holy See, to the figures of the Servite Friar Paolo Sarpi, the philosopher Giordano Bruno and the

courtesan Veronica Franco.




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Merletto Lace: a truly handmade refinement

Burano's ancient art and tradition

ace, merletti, is the prince of artisanal products of the Island of Burano, of its history, tradition, and of the incredible talent of the inhabitants of the island: it is an art that has been passed down for centuries.

In Burano, the **Bon family** has been running the "La Perla Gallery" shops for generations; a production reality that passes down the tradition of lace making while maintain a local feel. A family of master lace makers that has designed, produced, and exhibited works of art for generations... entirely made by hand with needle, thread, and talent!

workmanship is fascinating, and the final product is even more so: tablecloths, centerpieces, linens, sheets, clothes, and dozens of other artistic "inventions". "La Perla Gallery" is also open as an exhibition space, where it is possible to attend the extraordinary production of original Burano lace, explained step-by-step by collaborators of the Bon family. Numerous masterpieces of manual talent are displayed inside the Gallery, and many famous visitors have come here to discover this ancient art.

Years of tradition for the delight of tables and palates



he "Bussolà" of Burano is the simple donut-shaped cookie you see in Venice. It was once prepared by fishermen's wives for their husbands, each carring their cookies to the bakery oven to be cooked, and then at home leaving the same cookie among the bedding to perfume them (and then finally to be eaten !!).

Carmelina Palmisano began working in the family bakery (active since 1928) so young that she needed a stool to serve customers at the counter.

SPORT

In the camping it is impossible not to think about sport activities, with nine tennis courts, soccer and 5/5 soccer fields, mini-golf course and multi-purpose track also for skating. In addition, there are scheduled activities for fitness, swimming, jogging, archery, kayak and Nordic-walking.

PET FRIENDLY

One of the main assets of the camp is the possibility to bring your four-legged companions with you: they will be able to experience at the dog camp a dedicated

swimming pool with instructor, bath on the beach, have a personal **dog sitter** and a **H24 veterinary service**.

FARO DI CAVALLINO

The lighthouse of Cavallino, or Piave Vecchia, was erected by the Austrians for military purposes, today it hosts the offices of the local Harbor master.

FARO DI PUNTA SABBIONI

Nicknamed "Pagoda", it is 26 meters tall and its characteristic is to be painted in black and white checkered.

BORGO DI LIO PICCOLO

Famous for the "castraure", the artichoke bud, the area dates back to the Roman imperial era. In the square it is possible to admire the eighteenth-century manor house and the tower bell.

SACCAGNANA

Among the beauties of the territory it is possible to admire Villa Zanella, a Renaissance manor house built in the sixteenth century.

MESOLE

Between Lio Piccolo and the coast, here stands a building dating back to the fourteenth century, the Convent of Mesole.

FORTEVECCHIO (O FORTE DI TREPORTI)

Built by the Austrian government on the remains of a pre-existing French fort, it was the most important defense of Punta Sabbioni-Lido.

Urban cleaning by hand: how to keep a city with 30 million visitors clean

350 people

900 wastebasket

10 electrical

sweepers

80 boats

A team of over 350 people, 80 boats, and a dozen small electric sweepers to ensure the cleanliness of Venice. Every day, Veritas - the public service that manages urban health and hygiene in Venice and its provincial territory - takes care of the city, from dawn to dusk: first with the sweeping; then with door to door collection of waste produced by inhabitants, business activities, and tourists; and

again with the sweeping to keep Venice clean. This is a very demanding task because Venice is a city that requires special needs and most activities must be managed by hand.

To collect the waste, the city was divided into about 150 areas, each entrusted to a

garbage collector. Between 6 and

8am, the operator sweeps his area and empties public wastebaskets; citizens may carry their trash bags (with the separate collection waste of the day) to Veritas boats that are moored in the main city canals. Then, door-to-door waste collection begins: the operator (equipped with a cart) rings the doorbells, citizens hand him directly their trash bags, and the carts are emptied onto the Veritas boats.At midday, the city is perfectly clean.

Afterwards, the waste is transferred to a larger boat that leaves for Fusina (in the industrial area of Porto Marghera) where they are treated in one of the most advanced waste disposal platforms in Italy and Europe.

> The materials that have been separately collected are brought to processing and recycling facilities, while mixed waste is turned into fuel and is used, together with coal, to produce electricity (only case in Italy).

This way, Venetian citizens are able to get electricity from their waste. Once waste collection is completed

the city cleansing operations restart, going on until late in the evening. Garbage collectors sweep the streets and clean the ground, even using small electric sweepers designed specifically for Venice. In addition, they empty the approximately **900 wastebaskets** in the city, even 5-6 times a day in central tourist areas like St. Mark's Square.



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
